About the Position

The Seward County Planning Commission makes recommendations to the Seward County Board of Commissioners on land use issues such as rezoning, subdivisions, conditional use applications, and amendments to the Comprehensive Plan, Zoning and Subdivision Regulations.

Application Acceptance

The Seward County Board of Commissioners accepts applications year-round. When there are openings on the Planning Commission, applications will be reviewed, and candidates will be contacted for interviews.

Details

The Planning Commission is a nine-member board • A member serves a three-year term. • The Planning Commission consists of a broad representation of members from across Seward County. • Meetings are held on the third Monday of the month at 7:30 pm at the Seward Civic Center.

Requirements & Duties

- Resident of rural Seward County for at least 12 months (prior to appointment)
- Registered voter
- Attend monthly meetings
- Do necessary independent research for items on agenda prior to meetings
- May be required to attend other meetings or training.

Desired Qualifications & Interests

There are no minimum skills and abilities that an applicant must have to be appointed as a Planning Commissioner, however, there are skills and abilities that make a quality Planning Commissioner such as listening, having knowledge or understanding of issues related to Seward County zoning, being prepared, analytic ability, ability to communicate, being fair and open-minded, and relevant experience.
